An Udayan Shalini Fellow – North Delhi Chapter

Udayan Shalini Fellows are young women, intelligent and ambitious, but whose families make less than \$2000/year. The Fellowship provides them with financial, training, and mentoring support for 5-6 years, from 11th grade through college.

Ankur is an embodiment of the words- ‘Hard work’, ‘Dedication’ and ‘Perseverance’. Ankur’s father was the family’s sole bread winner and barely made enough to pay the rent and three meals a day for his family. However, this did not stop Ankur from her dreams of attending college.

Ankur joined the Udayan Shalini Fellowship program seeking financial aid to support her education. Currently, Ankur is pursuing her bachelors degree in Home Sciences from the Institute of Home Economics at Delhi University.

‘I joined the program expecting only financial support, however what I received was much greater. At every step, I was supported unconditionally by my mentors and my fellow Shalinis. This helped me in becoming more outspoken and confident. It felt like a home, where I am looked after, guided in the right direction and taken care of.’
