Udayan Care is doing great things, addressing daunting problems in a powerful and effective way. We believe that through our efforts, we can help change how society thinks about issues like girls' education, youth skill development, and alternative care models.

Udayan Care India is a 28-year-old organization working with children and youth. Headquartered in Delhi, it has expanded across 36 cities and 15 Indian states. It runs 16 childcare homes for orphaned and abandoned children in 4 different states. It runs programs for empowering young women through education, skills training, and job placement. To date, Udayan Care has helped to change the lives of over 37,500 young people and their families.

The **Udayan Ghar Program** aids orphaned and abandoned children, providing permanent, family-like homes under the loving care of mentor parents. These homes are managed by a team of program staff, which includes social workers, caregivers, educators, and counselors. After they turn 18 and leave their homes, Udayan Ghar children continue to receive support through the Aftercare program. This program provides a range of assistance, from paying academic fees and living expenses to providing accommodation, vocational training, and mental health counseling. The Udayan Ghar and Aftercare programs have served over 1,600 children to date.

The **Udayan Shalini Fellowship Program** is a deep-impact, transformative leadership program for disadvantaged girls at risk of dropping out of school. The USF program provides them with resources, training, and financial support through their final years of high school. The program has touched over 13,500 girls in the 20 years since its launch.

The **Udayan Care IT Program** is a training program targeting underprivileged youth. It offers short-term certificate and diploma courses at a nominal fee in IT and ITES skills, coupled with employability and personality development skills training. It also offers placement support to help students get jobs. The program is offered in 19 centers across 4 states and has impacted over 22,500 youth since its inception.

All of Udayan Care's programs are grounded in two foundational pillars: the spirit of volunteering and the spirit of giving back. The organization has been able to make a difference in so many lives because of the thousands of volunteers that have dedicated themselves to Udayan Care's mission, giving more than three million hours of their time and energy. It has likewise been a priority to instill the same spirit of "giving back" in all of the young people served by Udayan Care's programs. This goal has helped to make these young women and men more socially conscious and sensitive citizens.
